Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:100 - Section 10. Standards for the Provider.

(1)(a) Between July 1 and June 30 of Each Subsequent Year of Operation, a Provider Shall Complete at Least Nine (9) Hours of Cabinet-approved

early Care and Education Training, Including One and One-half (1 1/2) Hours of Cabinet-approved Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma Training Completed

once Every Five (5) Years in Accordance with KRS 199.8982(2).

(b) A Provider or Assistant's Compliance with the Training in Accordance with Paragraph (A) Of (1) and 922 KAR 2:100 - Section 10. Standards for the Provider.

(8) An Assistant Used in Excess of Fourteen (14) Calendar Days During a One (1) Year Period Shall Demonstrate Completion of at Least Nine (9) Hours

of Cabinet-approved Training Between July 1 and June 30 of the Following Calendar Year Beginning the Second Year of Employment, Including:

(a) Six (6) Hours of Cabinet-approved Training in Accordance with KRS 199.8982(2); And

(b) Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma Training Pursuant to KRS 199.8982(2) (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
