Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements. (16) In Accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a Staff Person with Supervisory Authority Over a Child Shall Complete the Following:

- (a) Six (6) Hours of Cabinet-approved Orientation Completed Within the First Three (3) Months of Employment in a Child-care Program;
- (b) Nine (9) Hours of Cabinet-approved Early Care and Education Training Within the First Year of Employment in a Child Care Program, Including One and One-half (1 ½) Hours of Cabinet-a (2), 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.
