1 Important

Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(25) Supports for Climbing Apparatus and Large Equipment Shall Be Securely Fastened to the ground.

(26) Crawl Spaces, Such as Tunnels, Shall Be Short and Wide Enough to Permit Access by adults.

(27) A Sandbox Shall Be:

(a) Constructed to Allow for Drainage;

(b) Covered When Not in Use;

(c) Kept Clean; And

(d) Checked for Vermin Prior to use.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, Two (2) Pieces of Climbing Equipment in the Outdoor Play Area, The (1). The single finding was not critical.
