Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:090. Section 8. General.

(1) A Licensee Shall:

(a) Be Responsible for the Operation of the Child-care Center Pursuant to This Administrative Regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; And

(b) Protect and Ensure the Health, Safety, and Comfort of Each child.

Findings:

General: Based on Interview and Review of Video Documentation Dated 06/12/25, the Following Was Found in the Early Head Start classroom:

1.) A Staff Member Inappropriately Lifted Up a Three-year-old Child by Both Arms F (1), 922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

(7) The Following Shall Be Inaccessible to a Child in Care:

(a) Toxic Cleaning Supplies, Poisons, and Insecticides;

(b) Matches, Cigarettes, Lighters, and Flammable Liquids; And

(c) Personal Belongings and Medications of staff.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation and Interview, a Staff Member's Jacket Hung on an Adult Rocker Chair in Meade II Classroom. (1), and 922 KAR 2:120. Section 13. Toys and Furnishings.

(5) Tables and Chairs Shall Be of Suitable Size for children.

(6) Chairs Appropriate for Staff Shall Be Provided to Use When Feeding, Holding, or Playing with a child.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation and Interview, Chairs Were for Children in the Meade Early Head Start and Meade II Classroom. Seating for Staff Members Was Not provided.
