Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.

(1) A Child-care Center Shall Maintain:

(a) A Current Immunization Certificate for Each Child in Care Within Thirty (30) Days of the Child's Enrollment, Unless an Attending Physician or The child's Parent Objects to the Immunization of the Child Pursuant to KRS 214.036;

General: Based on Observation and Interview, a Bottle of Lysol Spray Was in an Unlocked Desk Drawer in the Three-year-olds' Classroom. (1), and 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(20) An Outdoor Play Area Shall Be:

- (d) Safe From Foreseeable Hazard;
- (e) Well Drained;
- (f) Well Maintained;
- (g) In Good Repair; And
- (h) Visible to Staff at All times.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, Black Weed Block Was Raised Above the Protective Surface and Presented a Tripping Hazard in the Outdoor Play Area. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
