Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:100 - Section 19. Records.

(1) A Provider Shall Maintain:

(a) A Current Immunization Certificate for Each Child in Care Within Thirty (30) Days of the Child's Enrollment, Unless an Attending Physician or The child's Parent Objects to the Immunization of the Child Pursuant to KRS 214.034;

Findings:

General: Based on Interview and Review of Documentation, a Child (SD: 11/19/22) Immunization Certificate Was Current Until 04/22/25. The Provider Was Aware the Immunization certificate Was No (2), 922 KAR 2:100 - Section 2. Certification Process.
