Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.

(1) A Child-care Center Shall Maintain:

(a) A Current Immunization Certificate for Each Child in Care Within Thirty (30) Days of the Child's Enrollment, Unless an Attending Physician or The child's Parent Objects to the Immunization of the Child Pursuant to KRS 214.036;
