Across 5 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:120. Section 2. Child Care Services.

a. Within Scope of Vision and Range of Voice;

c. Accounted for During Movement From One (1) Location to Another Using Name-to-face Recognition by Visually Identifying Each child;
