Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the Surveyor Found the following:

1. The Mulch Around the Outside Play Structure Was depleted.
2. There Was a Dome Style Play Structure That Did Not Have a Safe Fall Zone That Was Equal Height as the Play structure.

Therefore, the Playground Was Not Safe From an Unavoidable Danger or Risk. (1). The single finding was not critical.
