1. A Communicable Disease Pursuant to 902 KAR 2:020, Which Shall Also Be Reported to the Local Health department;
2. An Accident or Injury to a Child That Requires Medical care;
3. An Incident That Results in Legal Action by or Against the Family Child-care Home That:
 - a. A (1) and 922 KAR 2:100 - Section 10. Standards for the Provider.

(8) An Assistant Used in Excess of Fourteen (14) Calendar Days During a One (1) Year Period Shall Demonstrate Completion of at Least Nine (9) Hours

of Cabinet-approved Training Between July 1 and June 30 of the Following Calendar Year Beginning the Second Year of Employment, Including:

(a) Six (6) Hours of Cabinet-approved Training in Accordance with KRS 199.8982(2); And

(b) Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma Training Pursuant to KRS 199.8982(2) (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
