(b) Protect and Assure the Health, Safety, and Comfort of Each child.

General: Based on Observation, the Boy's and Girl's Bathrooms Next to the Gym Contained Unprotected Electrical Outlets on the Wall Next to a Stall and on the Wall Next to A handwashing sink.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a Staff Member (DOH: 08/01/16) Had a TB Skin Test on File That Was No Longer Current. The TB Skin Test Expired on 9/9/2023.
