Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:120. Section 7. First Aid and Medicine. (8) Each Center Shall Ensure That Every Staff Member Has Received Training on First Aid and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR).
