Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:280. Section 11. Status of Employment. (1) A Child Care Provider Shall Maintain the Employment or Residential Status of Each Child Care Staff Member Who Has Submitted to a Fingerprint-based Criminal Background Check by Reporting the Status Using the NBCP Web-based system.
