Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the Following Were found:

1) One (1) Child's File (DOE: 09/26/23) Did Not Contain an Immunization Record. The Child Has Been Enrolled More Than Thir (2) and 922 KAR 2:100 - Section 15. Food Requirements.

(15) Except if Thawed for Preparation or Use, Frozen Food Shall Be Kept at a Temperature of Zero Degrees Fahrenheit as Verified by a Thermometer In the freezer.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the Surveyor Was Unable to Determine if the Freezer's Temperature Was Zero Degrees Fahrenheit as the Provider Was Unable to Locate a Temperature-measuring Device in the freezer.
