Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:280. Section 11. Status of Employment. (1) A Child Care Provider Shall Maintain the Employment or Residential Status of Each Child Care Staff Member Who Has Submitted to a Fingerprint-based Criminal Background Check by Reporting the Status Using the NBCP Web-based system.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and Interview, the Surveyor Found a Current Staff Member (DOH: 07/01/2005) Was Listed on the Child-care Center's Kentucky Applicant Registry and Employment System's (1) and 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(20) An Outdoor Play Area Shall Be:

- (d) Safe From Foreseeable Hazard;
- (e) Well Drained;
- (f) Well Maintained;
- (g) In Good Repair; And
- (h) Visible to Staff at All times.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the Surveyor Found That the Protective Surface Padding on the Playground Had a Large Crack That Followed Down the Side of the Playground to the End of the Fence Area; Therefore, the Playground Was Not Kept Maintained and the Playground Was A (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
