Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements. (9) Floors, Walls, and Ceilings Shall Be Smooth, in Good Repair, and Constructed to Be Easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation and Interview, a Dark, Dried, Softball-sized Stain Was Observed on One (1) Ceiling Tile Located Above the Doorway in Room A3. (2), 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(25) Supports for Climbing Apparatus and Large Equipment Shall Be Securely Fastened to the ground.

(26) Crawl Spaces, Such as Tunnels, Shall Be Short and Wide Enough to Permit Access by adults.

(27) A Sandbox Shall Be:

- (a) Constructed to Allow for Drainage;
- (b) Covered When Not in Use;
- (c) Kept Clean; And
