Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements. (9) Floors, Walls, and Ceilings Shall Be Smooth, in Good Repair, and Constructed to Be Easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the Surveyor Found the Wall Flashing Was Exposed on a Grey Wall in Room A3; Therefore, the Wall Was Not in Good Repair. (2), 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(16) In Accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a Staff Person with Supervisory Authority Over a Child Shall Complete the Following:

**General: Based on Observation of the Boys' Restroom, the Surveyor Found a Six (6) Inch Section of Paint Was Missing From the Wall Located Behind the Toilet. The Missing Paint exposed the Drywall; Therefore, the Wall Was Not in Good repair.**

**General: Based on Observation of the Playground, the Surveyor Found the Plastic Border Around the Mulch Had Two (2) Metal Steaks Protruding Upward Creating a Potential Foreseeable hazard.**
