Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements. (9) Floors, Walls, and Ceilings Shall Be Smooth, in Good Repair, and Constructed to Be Easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation and Interview, Five (5) Brown Stains Were on a Ceiling Tile, and One (1) Brown Stain Was on a Second Ceiling Tile in the Preschool Room. The Stains

ranged in Length From One (1) to Four (4) Inches Long. (2), 922 KAR 2:120. Section 7. First Aid and Medicine.
