Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialist Did Not Observe Physician's Information Listed on an Emergency Form. (1), Licensing Specialist Observed Medication That Was Expired at the Facility. (1), and Licensing Specialist Did Not Observe That the Facility Ensured the Safety and Security of Each Child at All Times. There Was a Child at That Facility Who Was Left Unattended for Around 3-4 Minutes. (1). None of the 9 findings were critical.
