Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were LS Did Not Observe All of the Required Information on the Emergency Forms. Provider Must Immediately Submit All of the Corrections. (4), LS Did Not Observe a Lead Test for Every Child Enrolled. Provider Must Immediately Submit Evidence of a Lead Test or Evidence of an Appointment to Obtain a Lead Test. (2), and LS Did Not Observe the Annual Update for the Home's Emergency and Disaster Plan. Provider Must Immediately Submit Evidence of an Updated Plan. (1). None of the 10 findings were critical.
