(2), and There Were 4 Children Outside Without the Provider or Substitute When Specialist Arrived. 3 of the Children Were Not in Care with the Provider but One Was. The Child Is 5 Years Old. Provider or the Substitute Must Be Outside with Any Child Who Is Under 6 Years of Age. Provider Came Out with the Infa (1). None of the 14 findings were critical.
