Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialist Observed Immunizations Missing for One Child, an Incomplete Health Inventory II Form for Another Child, and No Evidence of Blood Lead Testing in One Child's Record. (2), Licensing Specialist Observed Children Enrolled and Present That Do Not Have Complete Emergency Forms. One Child Enrolled and Present Also Has an Incomplete Health Inventory II Form. (1), and Licensing Specialist Observed One Enrolled and Present Child Without Evidence of Appropriate Blood Lead Testing. (1). None of the 13 findings were critical.
