Across 1 inspection since 2024, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialist Did Not Find the Health Inventory and Appropriate Lead Screening for Two Children in Care. Additionally, the Emergency Forms of Two Children Do Not Have Their Physician's Information. (1), Licensing Specialist Observed Diapers Being Disposed of in a Bag and Then Taken Outdoors. The Provider Was Reminded to Follow Established Diapering Procedures. (1), and Licensing Specialist Observed an Emergency Form That Stated a Child Was Allergic to Nuts. However, No Medication Authorization Was Provided. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
