Provider Shall Send Documentation That Two of the Four Infants She Has Enrolled Have Been Disenrolled From Care. (1), and LS Observed Cleaning Agents Under the Counter of Bathroom Sink at Time of Inspection. Provider Removed Cleaning Agents at Time of Inspection. (1). None of the 6 findings were critical.
