Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were A Three Year Old Child Ran Out of Classroom 8. (2), A Challenging Student Ran Out of Classroom 8; A Teacher Was Able to Redirect Him Back to the Classroom However, the Child Was Able to Open the Door and Run Out the Classroom. (2), and A Child Ran Out of the Three Year Old Room There Were Three Staff Members Present the Teacher Was Able to Redirect Him However, He Was Able to Cross Doorway Into the Hallway. The Child Was Identified as a Child with Challenging Behaviors and Has a Behavior Log. (1). None of the 13 findings were critical.
