Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Specialist Observed No Evidence of Completion of the 2023 Basic Health and Safety Training by the Provider, Which Was Due No Later Than March 31, 2024. Provider Shall Complete the Training and Submit Evidence of Completion. (4), Provider Shall Submit Privacy Rights Forms for Provider and Substitute. (1), and Specialist Observed That Two Emergency Forms Were Not Maintained as They Were Missing Information. Provider Shall Obtain Corrected Emergency Forms and Submit Copies or Submit a Letter of Corrections That the Children Will Not Return to Care Until Complete. (1). None of the 7 findings were critical.
