(1), and At the Time of the Inspection the LS Observed the Teacher Use Her Foot to Kick a Chair and It Hit the Back of the Child's Legs. LS Informed the Teacher That the Behavior Was Inappropriate and to Use Another Way to Place the Chair Under the Child. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
