Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Several Rooms Need the Carpet-to-tile Strip Repaired. Operator Is Using Duck Tape to Cover Strips That Are Cracked/broken. (2), One Staff Member Needs to Complete 8 Hrs of Training and a Second Staff Member Needs to Complete 7 Hrs of Training by March 31, 2026. Professional Development Plans Were Not Being Maintained for 6 Staff Members. (1), and Professional Development Plans Were Not Being Maintained for 5 Staff Members. (1). None of the 13 findings were critical.
