Across 5 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialist Observed 31 Children in Room 7 (School Age) Approved Only for a Capacity of 30. LS Observed 21 Children in Room 2 (Preschool) Approved Only for a Capacity of 20. (2), Licensing Specialist Did Not Observe Adequate Supervision for Children in Rooms 3A (Infants), 3B (Infant/toddler), and 5A (Toddler); Only One Staff Person Was Present During Nap Time. (2), and An Aide Georgia Jones Did Pick Up a Child by One Arm. The Director Did Address and Discuss the Concern with Staff But, It Was Not Reported to the Office of Child Care. (2). None of the 12 findings were critical.
