Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Specialist Could Not Verify That an Emergency Preparedness Plan Has Been Completed. (2), A Child in Care Does Not Have a Health Inventory on File. The Child Does Have Shot Records From Another State but the Health Assessment Has Not Yet Been Completed. There Is No Emergency Card on File for the New Child. (1), and No Updated Shot Record on File for a Child in Care. No Health Inventory on File a Child in Care. No Updated Lead Results for 3 Children in Care (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
