Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The LS Observed That the Children's Emergency Forms Need to Be Updated. (2), The LS Observed That the Provider Needs to Replace the Lattice in Her Outside Area, and the Grass Needs to Be Mowed. The Outdoor Area Needs to Be Organized, Free From Hazards. (2), and The LS Had the Provider Move the Eight Year Old Down to the Room of Care. (2). None of the 14 findings were critical.
