Facility to Submit a Written Statement Verifying That the Parent Agreements Have Been Obtained and Are Accessible in the Child Files. (1), and Ls Observed 4 Children's Emergency Cards That Were Either Not Complete or Updated. Facility to Submit a Written Statement Verifying That All Emergency Cards Have Been Completed And/or Updated, Obtained, and Are Accessible in the Child Files. (1). None of the 7 findings were critical.
