Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were When Reviewing Staff There Were Five New Staff That Had Never Been Reported to the Office of Child Care. (2), During the Inspection, the Director Kept Leaving the Room. Licensing Specialist Reminded Her That She Is the Only Qualified Staff and She Must Remain in the Room with the Children at All Times. (1), and Licensing Specialist Observed a First Aid Kit That Was Missing: A Flashlight, Paper Towels and Wash Cloths. Facility Is Asked to Submit Photographic Evidence of Adding the Missing Items to the First Aid Kit. (1). None of the 14 findings were critical.
