Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were In Room 5, the Trash Can Was Dirty. In Room 4, the Step Stools Were Dirty. (2), There Was a Restroom That Did Not Have Toilet Paper and Soap. A Staff Member Placed a Roll of Toilet Paper and Soap in the Restroom During the Inspection. (1), and In the 2's Playground, a Part of the Plastic Border Was Laying on the Ground. The Border Was Fixed During the Inspection. The 3's Playground Did Not Have Mulch by the Slides. The 4's Playground Did Not Have Mulch Under the Swings. On the Infants Playground the Grass Was High Under the Climbing Struc (1). None of the 13 findings were critical.
