(3), Licensing Specialist Noticed the Bathrooms at the Facility Needed to Be Cleaned More Thoroughly. And to Make a Note of Cleaning the Area on the Floor Near the Trashcan in Room 3. (2), and Licensing Specialist Did Not See a Visual Sub Log for the Substitute in the Infant Classroom. (1). None of the 12 findings were critical.
