Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were There Is One Child Who Has Medication for Specific Allergies, However the Medication and Medication Authorization Form Is Not on Site. (4), There Is One Child Who Needs Authorized Pick Up People Identified and One Child's Emergency Card Has the Incorrect Name Listed at the Top. (3), and There Are 5 Children Who Have No Lead Testing Done and 2 Children Who Need the 2nd Lead Testing Completed. There Are 3 Children Who Are Missing Immunization. One Child's Emergency Card Has the Incorrect Name at the Top of the First Page and Another Child Is Missing the Authorized Pick Up Person List (2). None of the 14 findings were critical.
