Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were LS Observed Potentially Hazardous Food Being Stored in Lunch Boxes with Ice Packs in Children's Cubbies. This Is an Ongoing Concern That Has Been Cited Multiple Times with the Facility. (2), From the Sample of Files Reviewed, LS Did Not Observe a Written Agreement in Each Child's File. Facility Must Ensure That a Copy of Each Child's Written Agreement Is Being Maintained in Each Child's File. (1), and From the Sample Reviewed, LS Did Not Observe Evidence of Lead Testing in Each Child's File. Facility Must Immediately Provide Evidence of Lead Testing or Evidence of an Appointment to Obtain a Lead Test From a Health Care Provider. (1). None of the 14 findings were critical.
