(2), LS Observed 1 Instance of an Emergency Form Which Needs the Address for Two of the Child's Emergency Contacts. LS Also Observed 1 Instance of a Child in Need of a Second Lead Test Result. (2), and LS Did Not Observe the Full Emergency and Disaster Plan During the Inspection, but Provider Does Have an Evacuation Route Posted. (2). None of the 14 findings were critical.
