This Was Done During the Inspection. (1), and By the Fence That Surrounds the Playground, There Was a Wire with a Rusty Nail at the End of It. This Nail Was Out of the Hole It Is Supposed to Be In. The Nail Was Placed in the Hole During the Inspection. (1). None of the 10 findings were critical.
