(2), LS Observed No Evidence of Lead Screening Information in 4 Child Files. Director to Submit a Written Statement Verifying That All Lead Screening Information Has Been Obtained and Is Accessible in the Child Files. (1), and LS Observed No Evidence of Liquid Fragrance Free Soap in the First Aid Kit. Director to Submit Photographic Evidence That Liquid, Fragrance Free Soap Has Been Obtained and Is Accessible in the First Aid Kit. (1). None of the 6 findings were critical.
