Across 5 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Teacher Did Not Provide Adequate Attention During Free Play, Which Resolved in a Child's Hair Being Pulled. Teacher Was Terminated the Same Day of the Incident Due to Lack of Supervision. (2), Medication Was Not Properly Stored nor Signed in at a Child's Date of Enrollment. (2), and Center Has Chipping Paint in the 3 and 4 Year Old Classroom (1). None of the 14 findings were critical.
