Although There Was Additional (2), Old Staffing Pattern Posted but New Staffing Pattern Are Available. Corrected While on Site. (1), and During the Site Visit,, the Center Is Transitioning with Children Into Older Groups and Classrooms . For Instance, the Children in the Infant Room 18 to 23 Months Had One Child That Should Transition to 2 Year Old Room Had Not Been Moved Into the Two Year Old Room.
