Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Temperature of the Hot Water Exceeded 120 Degrees. (1), Storage Cabinet in the Lower Room Designated for Child Care and the Storage Shelve in the Kitchen Must Be Stabilized or Made Inaccessible to the Children. (1), and Bathroom Vanity , Kitchen Cabinets and Drawers Containing Potentially Hazardous Items Such as Sharp Implements, Cleaning Products Need a Child Proof Device or Stor Items High Out of the Reach of Children. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
