Across 1 inspection since 2024, the issues cited most often were LS Did Not Observe an Emergency Form for Each Child. (4), LS Did Not Observe Two Gauze Rolls, Paper Towels, Safety Pins, or a Triangular Bandage in the First Aid Kit as Required by the Licensing Agency. (1), and LS Did Not Observe a Thermometer in the Refrigerator. (1). None of the 6 findings were critical.
