Across 1 inspection since 2024, the issues cited most often were At Time of Inspection, Licensing Specialist Observed an Attendance List That Was Only Signed by 11/42 Children Enrolled and Present on 08/19/2024. (1), At Time of Inspection, Facility Did Not Have an Emergency Form for a Child Present and Enrolled in Care. The Facility Contacted the Child's Parent to Submit the Form via Email. (1), and At Time of Inspection, Licensing Specialist Observed Emergency Forms That Were Not Signed And/or Updated Annually by the Child's Parent. Licensing Specialist Also Observed Emergency Forms Missing the Physician Information. (1). None of the 10 findings were critical.
