Facility Needs to Obtain Copies of the Children's Health Inventories and Submit Copies to Licensing Specialist. (1), and Licensing Specialist Observed Three Children Enrolled Who Were Missing Their Lead Testing Documentation. Facility Needs to Obtain and Submit Copies of the Missing Lead Test Documentation to Licensing Specialist for the Three Children. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
