Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Complaint States That on May 12 an Aide Pulled a Child's Arm Toward Her and the Child Fell Forward Into the Aide. The Aide Stood the Child Back Up and Then the Child Was Walking Around Holding His Left Arm and Crying. Findings: Viewed the Video and It Shows the Aide in the Classroom with the Childre (2), Complaint States That on May 12 an Aide Pulled a Child's Arm Toward Her and the Child Fell Forward Into the Aide.
