The Staff in the Building Know Her Behaviors. Once It Was Realized That the Child Was No Longer in the Room the Aide Left to Look for the Child. LS Suggested That the Facility Add Another Staff Member To (4), A Child Was Outside on the Playground Alone So the Child's Safety and Security Was Not Ensured. (3), and According to the Reporting Source, a Child Was on the Playground Unsupervised for Approximately 5 Minutes. Upon Further Investigation by the Facility, the Child Was on the Playground Unsupervised However It Is Unclear How Long the Child Had Been There. It Is Believe That the Child Had Not Been Out (2). None of the 13 findings were critical.
