Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were LS Did Not Observe That All Electrical Sockets Within Reach of Children on the Main Level of the Home Were Plugged or Capped. This Was Corrected During the Inspection When the Outlets Were Capped. (3), LS Observed the Homes Freezer in Need of Cleaning. (1), and LS Observed Several Piles of Unused Items, Trash, Chemicals, a Ladder, and Metal Materials in the Outdoor Play Area. LS Also Observed a Shed Missing Locks. (1). None of the 8 findings were critical.
