Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Facility Explained That a Child Was Left Outside for Less Than a Minuet During the Transition and Was Instantly Noticed by Another Teacher and the Child Was Recovered. (1), The Facility Explained That During the Transition From Outside to the Inside a Child Was Left Behind for Less Than a Minuet and Was Instantly Noticed by Another Teacher and the Child Was Recovered and Returned. (1), and LS Was Told That Parents Are Asked to Sign Child in and Staff Then Walk Children to Their Classrooms, LS Was Also Told That Parents Have Access to Classrooms Only on Special Occasions Such as Birthdays and Special Events. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
